Hoi Ha Wan - Shark Adventure

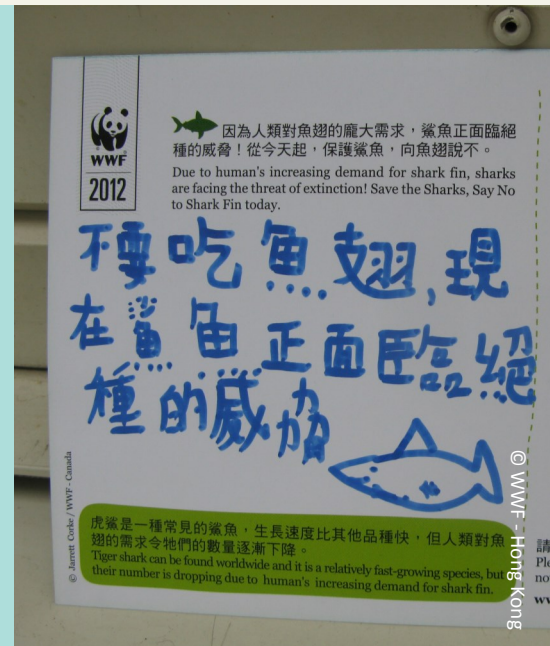
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Learn about interesting features of sharks and the threats towards sharks throughout their growth by mimicking a pup.

Coral observation (@ Glass-bottomed boat) ● Learn about one of the shark habitats—coral community	40min
Conclusion: Reflection and Q&A (@Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre)	35min
Walk to Hoi Ha Village*	20min
