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Carry out field studies at Sai Kung markets and observe the marine environment in Hoi Ha Wan, to investigate how to manage and conserve Hong Kong's fishery resources.

Field study reporting (@ Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand the overfishing issue and importance of having sustainable seafood 	30min
Coral observation (@ Glass-bottomed boat)	60min
Conclusion: Reflection and Q&A (@ Hoi Ha Marine Life Centre)	15min
Walk to Hoi Ha Village*	15min

Notes: *A 15-minute walking to the Centre along the trail with stairs and slopes.
