## Mai Po Nature Reserve – Mangrove Ecology

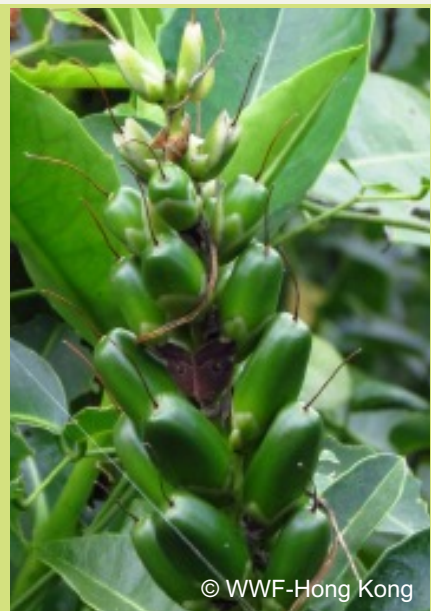
