Patrick led Coastal Watch, a citizen science project in WWF-Hong Kong, to study the marine litter problem as well as coastal biodiversity in Hong Kong. In this project, WWF-Hong Kong cooperated with various NGO partners and volunteers groups to investigate the sources of marine litter through scientific surveys. From the results of Coastal Watch project, he is developing new strategy for government, community and private sectors to collaborate together and form source reduction solutions to the marine litter problem, as well as facilitating regional cooperation.
